LIMITED ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW AVAILABILITY NOTICE

The Ohio EPA, through the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) program, is considering funding a wastewater improvements project which is subject to environmental review requirements. The proposed project consists of a wet-weather, high-flow pump station, an adjacent 750,000 gallon wet-weather storage basin, a force main and gravity drain between the pump station and storage tank, a back-up generator, and related appurtenances in Georgetown, Ohio. The purpose of the proposed project is to significantly reduce, if not eliminate, sanitary sewer overflows from the Possum Run Pump Station during as much as a ten-year storm event.

As Ohio EPA will be issuing a Limited Environmental Review (LER) document and an accompanying Final Finding of No Significant Impact (FNSI) on this project in the near future, this notice is to advise the public of the forthcoming posting of its LER document on its web site. A copy of the LER document also will be posted on the Village of Georgetown's web site and distributed to interested parties.
