ORDINANCE NO. 1187

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AND AUTHORIZING FUND TRANSFERS
WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Village of Georgetown (the "Village") to provide funding for salaries incurred from establishing and maintaining a part-time Fire/EMS staffing twelve hours a day seven days a week during fiscal year 2017 only;

NOW BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio, a two-thirds majority of all members thereof concurring as follows:


SECTION 1: That the Fiscal Officer of the Village of Georgetown be and hereby is authorized and directed to make the following fund transfers of money:

Transfer:	FROM:	General Fund (1000)	\$156,550.00
	TO:	Fire Fund (2902)	\$ 78,275.00
		EMS Fund (2906)	\$ 78,275.00

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and well-being of the residents of the Village in order to ensure the Village can provide continuous fire and EMS services to residents of the Village and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 3: That the Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

PASSED AND ADOPTED at a legally convened meeting of Council held on the 8th day of December, 2016.
