IN THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) or more of all members thereof concurring as follows:

SECTION 1. That the dedication to the public use of Kellie Terrace (formerly Leslie Drive) as shown on the recorded Plat of Richard Leslie Subdivision No. 1 Plat Book 4, Page 44 (Plat Cabinet 1, Page 322) of the Plat Records of Brown County, Ohio and as dedicated by Deed of Dedication recorded at Deed Book 245, Page 501 be and the same is hereby approved, accepted and confirmed.

SECTION 2. That this acceptance of Kellie Terrace as a public street of the Village of Georgetown is with the understanding of council that said street does not terminate in a cul-de-sac for the reason that the plat of said subdivision was laid out prior to the adoption of street specifications requiring a cul-de-sac in such circumstances.


SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.




