(AKA AMBERLY DRIVE) AS A PUBLIC STREET OF THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) or more of all members thereof concurring as follows:

SECTION 1. That the dedication to the public use of Amlin Drive, aka Amberly Drive, as a public street of the Village of Georgetown, as the same is shown on the recorded plat of Coburn Subdivision, Plat Book 5, Page 42 (Plat Cabinet 1, Slide 424) of the Plat Records of Brown County, Ohio, be and the same is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2. That from and after the effective date of this Ordinance, the said Amlin Drive, aka Amberly Drive, shall be known and considered as a public street and a part of the street system of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.




