ORDINANCE NO. 1132

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 599 AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 853 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN TO PROVIDE FOR THE MANNER OF PAYMENT OF THE SALARY OF THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 599 enacted by the Council of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio established the position of the Village of Georgetown, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance No. 599 further provided, in Section V thereof, that the salary of the Village Administrator would be paid from the various funds set forth therein in percentage amounts, and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance No. 853, enacted by the Council of the Village of Georgetown, Ohio January 14, 1993, the percentage allocation of the payment of the Village Administrator salary amended, and

WHEREAS, the percentage allocation of the Village Administrator salary as originally provided in said Ordinance No. 599 and as amended by Ordinance No. 853 is no longer equitable,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDNAINED by the Council of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio, two-thirds or more of all members thereof concurring as follows:

SECTION 1. Effective with the calendar year beginning January 1, 2013, the salary (and all applicable benefits) of the Village Administrator of the Village of Georgetown shall be paid from the following funds in accordance with the following schedule:

<u>Fund</u>	<u>Percentage</u>
General Fund	12.5%
Street Fund	12.5%
Water Fund	12.5%
Sewer Fund	12.5%
Electric Fund	12.5%
Trash Fund	12.5%
Cemetery Fund	12.5%
Income Tax Fund	12.5%

SECTION 3. That the dollar amount of the salary to be paid to the Village Administrator shall be established by Council from time to time.

SECTION 4. That Ordinance No. 853 be and hereby is repealed as being in conflict with this Ordinance.


SECTION 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Georgetown and more particularly for the reason that it is necessary to revise the manner of payment of the Village Administrator salary to enable

the government of this municipality to continue on a sound fiscal basis and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
