RESOLUTION NO. 1161

**A RESOLUTION MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION  
FOR THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission for Brown County, Ohio has issued an Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2017 for the Village of Georgetown, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary in order to appropriate for the expenses in the dollar amount equal to the Seat Belt Grant received by the Georgetown Fire/EMS Department for EMS supplies; and to appropriate for the expenses incurred from entering in to an employment contract with Doug Moormann/Development Strategies Group LLC that a supplemental appropriation be made based on said Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources to appropriate funds not heretofore appropriated,


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) or more of all members thereof concurring as follows:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated the additional revenues as set forth in the Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources received from the Budget Commission of Brown County previously unappropriated as follows:

SECTION 2. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary for the welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Georgetown and more particularly to insure the orderly affairs of government of the municipality and to provide for the usual daily operation of this municipality and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
