RESOLUTION NO. 1169

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION AND APPROVAL OF  
THE BROWN COUNTY ALL-HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN FOR THE  
BENEFIT OF THE RESIDENTS OF GEORGETOWN, OHIO**

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has established rules and regulations under 44 CFR Parts 201.6, which requires that “(f)or disasters declared after November 1, 2004, a local government must have a mitigation plan approved pursuant to this section in order to receive Hazard Mitigation Grant Program project grants”; and

**WHEREAS**, the Brown County Emergency Management Agency received a grant from FEMA to prepare such a mitigation plan entitled the “All-Hazards Mitigation Plan”; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the FEMA regulation 201.6 documentation that the plan has been formally adopted by the governing body of the jurisdiction requesting approval of the plan must be submitted.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio, a majority or more of all members thereof concurring as follows:


**SECTION 1:** That the All-Hazards Mitigation Plan of Brown County, Ohio, which is attached as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein by reference, be and is hereby adopted on behalf of the residents of Georgetown, Ohio for the benefit, health, safety and welfare of the citizens in order to address natural disasters that can affect the community pursuant to provisions of the Ohio Revised Code, including but not limited to Chapter 3750.

**SECTION 2:** The Administrator is authorized to enter into and execute any documents consistent with the adoption and implementation of the All-Hazards Mitigation Plan of Brown County, Ohio attached as Exhibit A.

**SECTION 2:** That the Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 3:** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
