ORDINANCE NO. 1213

AN ORDINANCE MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION
FOR THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission for Brown County, Ohio has issued an Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2018 for the Village of Georgetown, and

WHEREAS, the Village is constructing a parking lot and the Bicentennial Committee is constructing a park at the corner of Main and Cherry Street where the Bicentennial Committee expects to raise \$39,011.00 in donations and be awarded an ODNR Natures Work grant in the amount of \$32,107.00 the Village will cover the complete parking lot and public sidewalk expense; and that it is necessary in order to provide for these expenditures of this municipality that a supplemental appropriation be made based on said Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources to appropriate funds not heretofore appropriated,


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) or more of all members thereof concurring as follows:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated the additional revenues as set forth in the Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources received from the Budget Commission of Brown County previously unappropriated as follows:

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Georgetown and more particularly to insure the orderly affairs of government of the municipality and to provide for the usual daily operation of this municipality and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
