

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARY OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE AND PATROLMAN OF THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, OHIO

BE IT ORDAINED, by the council of the Village of Georgetown, Ohio:

SECTION I,

That the salary of the Chief of Police of the Village of Georgetown, Ohio be and the same hereby is fixed at the sum of nineteen hundred and fifty dollars per annum, payable in equal ~~one~~-monthly installments from the general fund of the Village of Georgetown.

SECTION II

That the salary of the patrolman for said Village of Georgetown be and the same hereby is fixed at the sum of eighteen hundred dollars per annum, payable ~~three~~ monthly from the general fund of the said Village.

SECTION III

That on and after the passage of this ordinance, the patrolman and Chief of Police of said Village are prohibited from soliciting or receiving any private remuneration whatever from any individual, corporation or public institution of the Village of Georgetown by reason of any services rendered or to be rendered.

SECTION IV

That Ordinance No. 234 be and the same is hereby amended so far as same is inconsistent with this ordinance.

SECTION V

That this ordinance shall come effective at the earliest period allowed by law.
