

ORDINANCE NO. 243

AN ORDINANCE TO FIX THE SALARY OF THE MAYOR AND OF THE AMOUNT OF HIS OFFICIAL BOND OF THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, OHIO.

BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. That beginning January 1, 1954, and each year thereafter, the salary of the Mayor shall be Two Thousand Dollars (\$ 2,000.00) per year, payable in equal quarterly installments of Five Hundred Dollars (\$ 500.00) each.

Section 2. That the Mayor of the Village of Georgetown, Ohio, before entering upon his duties, shall give bond in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$ 500.00)

Section 3. That this Ordinance is declared necessary by virtue of the enactment of Sec. 733.40 and Sec. 1905.21 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared necessary to provide compensation for the Mayor in lieu of costs in State Cases, which after January 1, 1954, in accordance with Sec. 733.40 Revised Code of the State of Ohio, shall be paid into the municipal treasury.

Section 5. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith be and the same hereby are repealed.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
