

ORDINANCE NO. 272

TO LEVY SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS TO CONSTRUCT WATER MAIN AND INSTALL FIRE HYDRANTS AND VALVES IN OHIO AVENUE AND NEW STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of constructing a water main and installing fire hydrants and valves in Ohio Avenue and New Street in the Village of Georgetown, Ohio, as heretofore reported to this Council by the Village Clerk, notice of the filing of which assessment has been given as required by law, be and the same is hereby levied and assessed upon all of the lots and lands in the Village of Georgetown, Ohio, abutting on said improvement as set forth therein, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands are now on file in the office of the Clerk of this Council, and which assessments are in proportion to the front foot of the property assessed, and are not in excess of any statutory or constitutional limitation.

SECTION 2. That the total assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be payable in cash within thirty (30) days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or, at the option of the owner, in ten annual installments with interest at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection of the same. All cash payments shall be made to the Treasurer of said Village. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Village Clerk to the County Auditor, as provided by law, to be by him placed on the

tax duplicate and collected as other taxes are collected.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Georgetown, in said construction of a water main and installing fire hydrants and valves in the aforesaid streets of the village, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
