

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE CLERK OF THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO, TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND DELIVERY OF A MOTOR VEHICLE TO BE USED AS A FIRE ENGINE, AND THE CONSTRUCTION AND DELIVERY UPON SAID MOTOR VEHICLE OF FIRE APPARATUS IN SUCH A WAY THAT THE SAME WILL CONSTITUTE A PUMPER EQUIPPED WITH THE NECESSARY HOSE, LADDERS, LIGHTING EQUIPMENT, FITTINGS AND TOOLS AS WILL CONFORM TO THE SPECIFICATIONS ON FILE WITH THE CLERK OF SAID VILLAGE AND TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND CLERK OF SAID VILLAGE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE AND DELIVERY OF SAID EQUIPMENT WITH A SUCCESSFUL BIDDER, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE PAYMENT THEREFOR IN DEFERRED PAYMENTS AS AUTHORIZED BY LAW OUT OF THE PROCEEDS OF A CURRENT TAX LEVY WHICH IS IN THE PROCESS OF COLLECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO, THREE-FOURTHS OR MORE OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING, as follows:

SECTION I.

That there is in the process of collection a special levy voted by the electors of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio, having as one of its purposes the purchase of fire fighting equipment, and that there now exists an urgent necessity for the purchase of such equipment, and there being on file with the Clerk of this village specifications of the type and character of equipment required, and being necessary to have said equipment constructed to meet said specifications, and said construction requiring considerable time, it is necessary that the Clerk of this Village proceed with publication of notice for the receipt of bids for the furnishing and delivery of equipment to meet said specifications, and that upon receipt of a proper bid or bids the Mayor and Clerk shall be authorized to enter into a contract for the construction and delivery of said fire fighting apparatus by the successful bidder, as determined by Council after the opening and tabulation of bid or bids; and for the payment of said equipment upon the deferred payment plan as provided by law out of the revenues collected from said special levy now in the process of collection.

Section II

That the Clerk be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to proceed with publication of notice to ~~public~~ receive bids according to law for the furnishing of fire fighting apparatus of the character set forth in the specifications on file in his office, and that after the opening and tabulation of bids, the Mayor and Clerk be and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract with the successful bidder as determined by Council for the construction and delivery of said fire fighting apparatus, and that deferred payments for said fire fighting apparatus be made, as

authorized by law for the purchase of such fire fighting apparatus out of the funds now in the process of collection as proceeds of a voted levy, and that out of said funds, as collected, there be appropriated a sufficient amount to meet said payments.

Section III

That this Ordinance be passed as an emergency measure for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the village of Georgetown, and shall be effective immediately upon its passage.

Section IV

That ^{all} ~~the~~ Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances, inconsistent herewith be, and the same hereby are repealed.
