ORDINANCE NO. 1230

**AN ORDINANCE MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION  
FOR THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission for Brown County, Ohio has issued an Official Certificate of Estimated Resources for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2017 for the Village of Georgetown, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to the appropriate the municipal income tax refund; and the additional donations received not previously appropriated in order to provide for the payment of expenses incurred by the Village of Georgetown for the 1926 Studebaker Fire Truck Restoration that a supplemental appropriation be made based on said Official Certificate of Estimated Resources to appropriate funds heretofore not appropriated,


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) or more of all members thereof concurring as follows:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated the additional revenues as set forth in the Official Certificate of Estimated Resources received from the Budget Commission of Brown County previously unappropriated as follows:

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Georgetown and more particularly to insure the orderly affairs of government of the municipality and to provide for the usual daily operation of this municipality and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
